Applicants must satisfactorily complete a Language Awareness and Teaching Ideas Task, a Free Writing Task and pass a Screening Interview to be accepted. Candidates must be able to demonstrate that their level of English, both spoken and written, is suitable for the demands of the course. The decision of the centre is final.</b></p>	
<p>The course is very intensive and challenging – equivalent to doing a whole undergraduate semester in one month. You should be aware that the demands of the course may exacerbate any condition that is likely to be aggravated by stress.</p>
